ACADEMIC YEAR 2015

Beginning Fall 2007, entering first-time freshmen enroll under the four-year Tuition Compact. The compact fixes tuition rates for four years and sets course fees and required campus fees in a four-year schedule. All other undergraduate (primarily transfer students) and graduate students pay the standard tuition rate.

** Pharmacy (PharmD) program rate structure with class starting in Fall 2014:

AY 2015-2018 entering junior residents will pay an academic year rate of \$21,350.

This rate includes tuition, course fees and campus fees and will stay the same for this class through AY 2018.

AY 2015-2018 entering junior nonresidents will pay an academic year rate of \$38,850.

This rate includes tuition, course fees and campus fees and will stay the same for this class through AY 2018.
