** Pharmacy (PharmD) program rate structure with class starting in Fall 2015:

AY 2016-2019 entering junior residents will pay an academic year rate of \$21,570.

This rate includes tuition, course fees and campus fees and will stay the same for this class through AY 2019.

AY 2016-2019 entering junior nonresidents will pay an academic year rate of \$39,250.

This rate includes tuition, course fees and campus fees and will stay the same for this class through AY 2019.
